The Johnson Scholarship			<p>Any Florida resident undergraduate student with a disability working on a first four-year degree can apply and they do not have to be registered with Student Accessibility Services (SAS). Additionally, incoming students who have not yet enrolled for the fall semester are also eligible and should submit high school or prior college transcripts. Awards, ranging from \$250 to \$1,500 per semester, are usually distributed in August prior to the end of the fall semester add/drop week.</p> <p>Successful candidates will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Be enrolled in at least nine (9) credit hours for Fall 2023 2) Receive financial aid and complete the FAFSA 3) Provide a personal statement detailing their experience with disability in education 4) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 as demonstrated by transcript; USF students who have been enrolled for at least one full semester may submit a copy of their degree works or an unofficial transcript. 5) Provide two letters of reference; upon request and if a student is registered with SAS, members of the SAS team in Tampa, Sarasota-Manatee or St. Petersburg campus offices may provide one letter of reference for a student 6) Provide disability documentation; students registered with SAS can write “Please use SAS Documentation” on their application materials <p>To apply: Go to https://jsf.bz/</p>	4/1/2023
